

Letter of Intent

on the

Cooperation

between

École nationale d'ingénieurs de Gafsa EniGa
(National Engineering School of Gafsa)

and

Institut für Werkstoffkunde IW
(Institute of Materials Science)

In order to internationalise higher education at both institutions, the IW and the EniGa hereby agree to cooperate in education, research and other related areas by developing joint projects and promoting mutual exchange.

The areas of cooperation may extend to any department, institution or programme existent at either university. Any specific initiative shall be subject to mutual consent, availability of funds and the approval of the responsible authorities at both institutions. Initiatives may include:

- Exchange of members and teaching staff
- Exchange of students
- Joint teaching projects and study programmes
- Joint research projects
- Joint publications and conferences

All specifications and further arrangements will be agreed upon separately. Both institutions assign a coordinator who will serve as point person and be in charge of developing the cooperation.

Both institutions strive to finance their partnership. Each party will cover their own costs of travel or other expenses. Deviating or additional financial arrangements will be agreed upon separately.

This letter of intent takes effect upon the date of signing by both parties. Changes to or the termination of this agreement have to be made in writing.


